

INFORMATION NOTICE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

FEREST RAIL S.r.l., with registered office in Udine, Via Roma, 43/b, 33100 Udine, Tax I.D. and VAT code IT02961090301 (hereinafter, "Data Controller"), as entity in charge of data processing, would like to inform you pursuant to art. 13 of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30.6.2003 (hereinafter, "Privacy Code") and art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 (hereinafter, "GDPR") that your data will be processed with the following methods and for the following purposes:

1. SUBJECT OF THE PROCESSING

The data Controller manages the personal data that identify a natural person (data subject), such as, for instance, name, surname, identification number, company name, address, telephone, e-mail, bank and payment data - hereinafter "personal data" or "data") that you provide in order to enter into a contract for the services supplied by the Controller.

2. PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING

The processing of personal data is performed:

A) without your specific consent (art. 24 lett. a), b), c) Italian Privacy Code and art. 6 lett. b), e) GDPR) for the following service purposes:

- to conclude contracts in order to provide service;
- to fulfill the pre-contractual, contractual and tax obligations arising from existing relationships with you;
- to fulfill requirements of laws, regulations, EU rules or other legal authority;
- to exercise the rights of the owner, for example defense in a court;

B) with your specific and distinct consent only (articles 23 and 130 of the Privacy Code and article 7 of the GDPR), for the following marketing purposes:

- to send you communications on the services offered and satisfaction assessments regarding the quality of the services offered via e-mail, mail and/or sms and/or telephone contacts.

Please note that if you are already one of our customers, we may send you commercial information on the Data Controller's products or services similar to the ones you've already used, unless you disagree (art. 130 par. 4 of the Data Protection Code).

3. DATA PROCESSING MODALITIES

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of the operations indicated in article 4 of the Privacy Code and article 4 n. 2) of GDPR and more precisely: collection, registration, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, dissemination, deletion and destruction of data. Your personal data are subjected to both paper and electronic and/or automated processing.

The Data Controller will process the personal data for the time necessary to fulfill the aforementioned purposes and in any case for no more than 10 years from the end of the service offered and no later than 2 years from the collection of data for Marketing Purposes.

4. ACCESS TO DATA

Your data may be made accessible for the purposes referred to in the articles 2.A) and 2.B):

- to employees and collaborators of the owner as people in charge and / or internal managers of the processing and / or system administrators;
- to third parties (for example, providers for the management and maintenance of the website, suppliers, credit institutes, consultants, insurance companies for the provision of insurance services, etc.) who carry out outsourced activities on behalf of the owner, as external managers of the processing.

5. DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA

Without the express consent of the subject (pursuant to ex art. 24 par. a), b), d) Data Protection Code and art. 6, letters b) and c)), the Controller can communicate your data for the aforementioned purposes to Supervisory Bodies, Judicial Authorities, insurance companies, as well as other subjects to whom disclosure is required by the law, in order to fulfil the purposes specified above. Such entities/subjects process the data as independent data controllers.

Personal data will not be communicated to any category of recipients and will not be disseminated in any manner whatsoever.

6. DATA TRANSFER

Personal data are stored on servers located in Udine, within the European Union. It remains in any case understood that the Data Controller, where necessary, shall have the right to move its servers, also outside of the EU. In this case, the Data Controller ensures from that moment on the transfer of data outside the EU will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of applicable law, after stipulation of the standard contractual clauses adopted by the European Commission.

7. NATURE OF THE PROVISION OF PERSONAL DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE DATA

The provision of personal data is required for the purposes referred to in art. 2. A). Refusal to provide the data will result in failure to supply the services referred to in art. 2.A).

The provision of personal data for the purposes referred to in art. 2. B) is optional.

You can, therefore, decide not to provide any data or deny the possibility of processing the data already provided: in this last case, you will not receive newsletters, commercial communications and advertising material concerning the services offered by the Owner. In any case, you will continue to be entitled to the services referred to in art 2.A).

8. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

As the Data Subject, you shall have the rights outlined in art. 7 of the Data Protection Code e in art. 15 of the GDPR, namely the rights to:

1. obtain confirmation of the existence of the personal data concerning the data subject, even though not yet recorded, and disclosure of the same in an intelligible form;

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2. obtain information on: a) the source of personal data; b) the purposes and procedures of processing; c) the logic applied in case of electronic processing; d) the identification details of the Data Controller, data processors and the authorised representative according to art. 5, par. 2 of the Data Protection Code and of art. 3, par. 1, of the GDPR) the recipients or the categories of recipients to whom personal data may be disclosed or who may get to know such data as the authorised representatives within the territory of the country, or as external data processors;

3. obtain: a) updates, rectification or integration of data (when required); b) deletion, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of the data processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed; c) the statement that the operations referred to in sections a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also with regard to their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case in which this fulfillment is impossible or involves using means clearly disproportionate to the safeguarded right;

4. object, in whole or in part: a) to the processing of personal data concerning you, even if relevant for the purpose of collection; b) to the processing of personal data for the purposes of direct sales or marketing, or sending advertising material or carrying out market research through the use of automated calling systems with no operators, through e-mail and/or traditional phone and/or mail marketing procedures. Please note that the data subject's right of objection set out in section b) for the purposes of direct marketing through automated means may extend to traditional means, and the data subjects may also exercise their right of objection only in part. Therefore the data subject may decide to receive communications either only through traditional means or through automated means, or neither of the above.

Where applicable, the data subject also holds the rights outlined in articles 16-21 of the GDPR (right to rectification, right to deletion, right "to be forgotten", right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object), and the right to complain to the Data Protection Authority.

9. HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS

You may exercise your rights at any time by sending:
